HISTORICAL ROUTE

ALL ATTRACTIONS ARE LOCATED IN THE SULTANAHMET AREA AND ARE WITHIN WALKING DISTANCE FROM EACH OTHER

Hagia Sophia Mosque

Hagia Sophia Mosque or Hagia Sophia (Ayasofya) is one of the main attractions of Istanbul often called the “Eighth Wonder of the World”. It is one of the greatest buildings of Byzantine culture.



Blue Mosque

The Blue Mosque or Sultanahmet Mosque (Sultanahmet Camii) is a masterpiece of Islamic and world architecture, one of the main symbols of Istanbul. It is so majestic that during prayer it can accommodate up to 10,000 people at a time



Basilica Cistern

Basilica Cistern (Yerebatan Sarnici) is a unique ancient monument, a reservoir from the 4th century. It was kept here an inexhaustible supply of water in case of drought or siege of the city



Topkapi Palace

Topkapi Palace (Topkapı Sarayı) is the main residence of many Turkish sultans, famous people walked within its walls and many issues of global importance were decided. Area 7000 thousand sq. m.



Grand Bazaar

Grand Bazaar (Kapalıçarşı) is a market where you can find absolutely everything and in unlimited quantities. The market occupies more than 66 streets and has about 4,000 shops.

The territory of the Grand Bazaar is a small town that even has a cemetery



GALATA ROUTE

Karakoy

Karakoy (Karaköy) is one of the best areas of Istanbul. Central, prestigious, expensive and bohemian. The epicenter of nightlife is located right here, located in the European part of the city



Galata Tower

Galata Tower (Galata Kulesi)

This is where you can start exploring the old city.
Height 140 m, (height of the tower 67 m and height of the hill 73 m)



Istiklal Street

Istiklal street (Istiklal Caddesi) is the most popular street of the city.

On Istiklal Caddesi, religious buildings of different faiths peacefully coexist. The street is no more than 1.5 km long, but you can walk here endlessly



WALKING THE BOSPHOROUS

Istanbul "from the water" is something incredible. The Bosphorus Strait simultaneously connects and separates Europe and Asia.

A cruise along the Bosphorus is a "must do" for a tourist in Istanbul. There are many cruises along the strait, everyone chooses the most suitable one for themselves. The walk can be organized both by private and public transport, because there are Vapuru ferries - the same urban transport as a trolleybus or tram in your city.



The ferry ride is paid for with the Istanbul Card, so before the "cruise" be sure to buy and top up the card.

The advantage of Vapuru is that you can get off at absolutely any stop and explore the area. For those who do not like to move around the city on their own, there are excursion boats.

Before the trip, be sure to buy a simit (bagel), the local seagulls will be grateful to you. And do not forget to take tea with you for the road, it is sold right there, in front of the ferry. Enjoy!

Dolmabahçe Palace

Dolmabahçe Palace it is a symbol of the rise and decline of the empire, there is nothing more majestic and grandiose in the whole world.

Huge areas, rich decoration and luxury, you will see all this when visiting the palace



Mosque Ortaköy

Mosque Ortaköy is the only large temple standing right on the seashore.

On the busy street of Istanbul you can admire the sea view, have a bite of delicious local street food



Arnavutköy

Arnavutköy is a fashionable area of the city, with charming wooden "palaces", previously it could only be approached from the strait. There are many fish restaurants here where you can have a tasty snack



Khedive's Palace

The Khedive Palace (Hidiv Kasrı) is a palace complex and former residence of the Viceroys of Egypt in Turkey located on a hilltop in the middle of a large forest area on the coast of the Bosphorus Strait.



ASIAN ROUTE

Maiden Tower

Maiden's Tower (Kız Kulesi) - according to historians, a piece of land broke away from the mainland and eventually became an island.

It is believed that the tower was once built to control the movement of ships and collect taxes



Kuzgundzhuk

Kuzguncuk is a beautiful, non-tourist, unique neighborhood with an interesting history. People of different nationalities have lived here for hundreds of years: Greeks, Jews, Armenians, Turks.

They say that due to such a close multinational connection, Kuzguncuk acquired its own unique flavor; the neighborhood even has its own "surzhik"



Majestic Chamlydza

The majestic Çamlıca Camii is the largest mosque in Istanbul and Turkey.

It will impress you with its size and beauty.

The mosque can accommodate more than 60,000 people.

The building also houses a library, a museum of Islamic art, art galleries, and conference rooms. Visible from many places in Istanbul



GROUP TOURS WITH GUIDE

The Princes' Islands (Prens Adaları) are 9 picturesque islands, here you will find peace and quiet after the crazy rhythm of the huge city.

There is no transport on the islands, there are pine forests and Byzantine landmarks around. In the warm season, cultural recreation can be combined with beach recreation.



MINIATURE PARK

Miniature Park

Miniature Park (Miniatürk) location for those who have limited time in Istanbul, it will be especially interesting for young tourists. Here in a couple of hours you can see absolutely all the sights of the city. 135 miniature copies of Turkish historical monuments at a scale of 1:25. In total, the park's territory is about 60,000 sq.m.

AQUARIUM in Istanbul is very popular not only among tourists, but also among local residents. An educational tour of the themed oceanarium will be interesting for children and adults. It will allow you to get much closer to the underwater world, which is still unknown to the end. The aquarium is divided into 16 geographical zones, each of which, is inhabited by underwater inhabitants of different regions of the world. About 1500 species and 15,000 sea and land inhabitants live in this marine oasis.



The highlight of the oceanarium is a huge aquarium with sharks, rays, tunas and other large creatures, where you can dive accompanied by an instructor. There is another amazing place here - a tropical rain forest (hall), where its imitation is reproduced in an exact copy. The climate, the noise and smell of the forest, the chirping of tropical birds and the rain, which sometimes pours "like from a bucket", just like in the tropics. Don't be afraid to get wet, you can find an umbrella at every step.

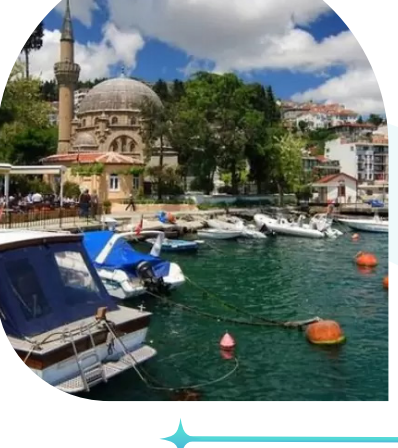

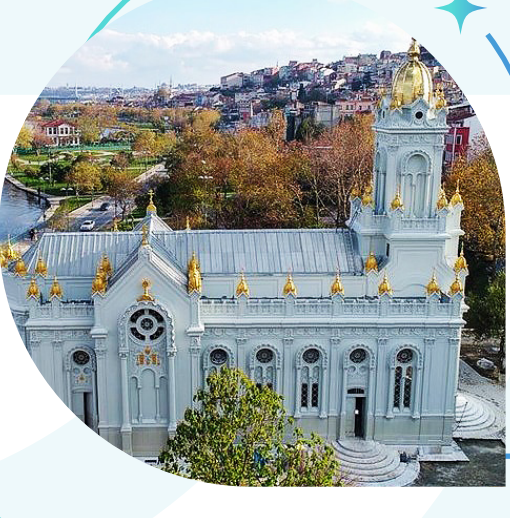

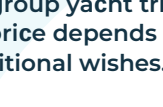
